

# RFAs issued -FY15 Cycle 1

---

## **Evidence-Based Cancer Prevention Services-Up to \$1.5 million for up to 36 months**

Delivery of preventive services e.g. vaccines, tobacco cessation interventions, and screening and early detection services for breast, cervical, and/or colorectal cancers

## **Competitive Continuation/Expansion for Evidence-Based Cancer Prevention Services -Up to \$1.5M for up to 36 months**

Focuses on the continuation or expansion of evidence-based services projects previously or currently funded






# Geographic Coverage
